Maximum tuition assistance allowable per individual is capped at \$8,000. Tuition assistance is only available if and after all TAP/PELL has been applied. Customers must apply, or they will be deemed ineligible for all applicable semesters. Tuition assistance is available at a rate of up to \$4,000 for each year based upon one half of the calendar term of the training program. On a case-by-case evaluation of a customer's needs, supportive services may be available up to \$1,000 for each annual term for a total of \$2,000. Additionally, should the individual qualify per the CSS WFNY Travel Policy, up to \$500 in mileage reimbursement assistance may be available for each annual term for a total of \$1000.
