## **WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS**

**How to Get Funded for Training** - The event will give an overview of how to access funding for training, discuss the requirements to access the funds, and go over what is needed to begin the process.

**Dress for Success** - Presenting yourself in an interview, to pick up an application or even drop off a resume. This workshop gives you assistance with dressing for success. What is appropriate for an interview at a construction site isn't what you would wear to an interview for a reception position.

**Career Exploration** - Attendees will be introduced to career assessments they can immediately utilize to identify their professional skills, interests, and values. Attendees will also learn about strategies and tools to use in their search for novel careers, as well as techniques to pinpoint career passions to guide career decisions.

**First 90 Days** - This workshop will help focus on the following topics: How to not lose your job in 90 days. The top reasons that employees lose their job in the first 90 Days.

**Financial Literacy** - You will learn about budgeting and planning ahead. This workshop is intended to present an introduction to budgeting to individuals who may not have had a lot of experience with money, or who are interested in upgrading their level of financial literacy. It covers banking, saving and prioritizing spending.

**Keeping Safe in a Digital World** - This workshop covers keeping your data safe now that everything from banking, to shopping, to job fairs and applying for work is all online. The need to have an increased awareness of keeping our data safe is of greater importance than it has ever been.

**Civil Service Employment** – Understanding the process of taking service exams, band scoring and process.

**Filing a Discrimination or Unpaid Wage Complaint** - Has your former employer not provided you with your last paycheck? Is your current employer not paying you for the overtime hours you worked? Are you working in a toxic workplace environment? This workshop provides an overview of the various types of discrimination found in the workplace, avenues available to address these concerns for both former and current employees, non-payment of wages and other issues.
