Level #3 Training Programs: All must be able to be completed within two (2) calendar years unless approved by the CSS WFNY Executive Director or designee. Maximum tuition assistance allowable per individual is capped at **\$8,000**. Tuition assistance is only available if and after all TAP/PELL has been applied. Customers must apply, or they will be deemed ineligible for all applicable semesters. Tuition assistance is available at a rate of up to \$4,000 for each year based upon one half of the calendar term of the training program. On a case by case evaluation of a customer's needs, supportive services may be available up to \$1,000 for each annual term for a total of **\$2,000**. Additionally, should the individual qualify per the CSS WFNY Travel Policy, up to **\$500** in mileage reimbursement assistance may be available for each annual term for a total of **\$1000**.
